Gold Country was created to provide consignors and buyers alike with another avenue to buy and sell high-quality ranch and performance horses. We are limiting entries to 30 horses. Horses entered will go through a sifting process including vet checks, dry work, trail obstacles and cow work. A team roping, calf branding, stock horse and snaffle bit classes will be offered to showcase your horse.

Along with your entry form please send in two photos and a video of each consignment. One photo will be used for the printed catalog. Both photos and the video will be included in the online catalog and posted on social media to better advertise to potential buyers. The video content is at your discretion. No submissions will be edited. Once we have received your entry you will be notified by phone or email that your consignment has been accepted to the sale.

Entries will close Sunday June 13th or once 30 entries have been reached. Please carefully review the rules and regulations of the sale. If you have any questions or concerns do not hesitate to contact Cameron Messier at (432) 381-9213 or office@goldcountryhorsesale.com.

Gold Country Horse Sale Rules and Regulations

Entries are limited to the first 30 horses consigned. If the entries limit is reached before the deadline of June 13, 2021 entries will close. No phone or verbal entries are accepted. Registration papers, entry fees, photos and videos must accompany entry. **If not completed your entry will be returned.** All horses entered must be entered in the name of the owner as it appears on the registration paper. **No double transfers** will be allowed.

- **All horses must have a negative Coggins test** within 6 months of the sale. Original Coggins test must be presented at time of check-in.
- Horses must be freshly shod (3 weeks or newer)
- Horses are required to be ridden, shown and sold in two cinches (front and rear)
- All horses must be shown with the same bit in the sale ring as they did in previews. The committee will be checking

Entry Fees are \$200.00 per horse entered and are non-refundable. The sale will take an 8% commission from the gross sale of each lot on sale day. Payments on consignments will be issued no more than 14 days from the date of the sale and will be made payable to the registered owner unless other arrangements have been made with sale management upon check-in.

The sale management reserves the right to refuse any entries that they deem are not up to sale quality.

Sifting will be Friday August 20th.

All consigned horses will be inspected for soundness, quality, structural problems and condition. A vet will be on site to examine each horse. If there are any visible abnormalities such as cuts, sores, etc. the committee will decide if it is a threat to the future value of the horse and sift or pass the horse. The committee has the right to sift a horse at any time before the sale. All fees on sifted horses are forfeited.

The sifting committee will inspect the consigned horses at halter. In doing so the horses will need to demonstrate having all four feet being easily picked up and be moved by their handlers in the committee determined patterns. Horses will also be bridled in front of the committee.

Horses passing the first part of the sift process, will then move on to work under a saddle which will include dry work, trail obstacles and cow work.

All horses not sifted must sell in the sale on Saturday August 21st.

Sale Order: Horses will sell in the lot number order.

Buy Back/ No Sales: All consignors will be given a bidder's number and have the right to protect their consignment. No bids will be accepted by any person from any individual in the sale ring or the warmup area. Winning bidders' names will be announced after the gavel drops on the lot and will be printed as such.

Stalls: Stalls will be provided to consignors at \$30 per horse per night. This will be deducted from consignors check. Pen maintenance is the responsibility of the consignor.

Photographs & Video: Each entry must be accompanied by two photographs of the horse entered as well as a video sent to office@goldcountryhorsesale.com. The photos will appear both in the print catalog and online, while the video will be posted online and on social media.
