

Terms and Conditions of Sale

1. All horses sell as is without warranty. It is the buyer's responsibility to examine the horses prior to purchasing to determine its condition and speak with consignors/sellers about any concerns.
2. Every effort has been made to assure correctness of the catalog; however, the seller, sale management and the auctioneer are not responsible for any errors or omissions. All comments in the catalog are from the consignors, not sale management. Right of recourse must be directed to the seller and not through the sale management. Management acts as agents only.
3. All horses will have a negative Coggins test and their general overall health verified upon entering the sale. Health certificates will be available if needed.
4. All prospective buyers must be properly registered and obtain a buyer's number from the sale office or XIT Western Productions if bidding online. XIT's additional terms and conditions will apply to sales made on their platform.
5. Each animal will be sold to the highest bidder. The decision of the auctioneer will be final if any questions arise during the sale. The auctioneer reserves the right to reject any bid. A recorded tape will be made of the entire sale which shall be used to settle any disputes regarding statements made about animals while they are in the auction ring.
6. Title and risk of loss passes to the buyer when the auctioneer says sold.
7. Buyer shall make payment in full for the horse purchased at the conclusion of the sale. Acceptable methods of payment are cash, check, or credit card. **All credit card purchases will be subject to a 3% service charge. California sales tax of 7.75% will be added to the sales price.** All checks to be made payable to Gold Country Horse Sale. Issuing a check with insufficient funds is a felony and will be handled as such. Horses may not leave the grounds until payment in full has been settled with the sale office. All horses must be off grounds by noon on Sunday August 28, 2022.
8. Buyers and spectators are cautioned to be careful while on the grounds and particularly while horses are being sold or shown in the sale ring or preview. By attending the sale, you accept full and total responsibility for your safety and hold Gold Country Horse Sale harmless of any responsibility.
